- Increase in information quality from anonymous dialogue with the whistleblower
- Increase in information quantity from lowering the inhibition threshold
- Structured and centralized acquisition of data from various sources
- Limitation of damage resulting in faster incident resolution
- Secure and discreet internal clarification about deviating acts
- Avoidance of financial losses or damage to the organization's reputation
- Highest currently available security standard from encrypted connection and content
- Inclusion of all organization members and partners in the risk management process
- Increased trust and value placed in the organization by investors and customers
- For companies listed on U.S. security exchanges: Compliance with legal requirements specified in the Sarbanes-Oxley Act
